# \$50M Capital Leverage Structuring Framework

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## Executive Summary

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This framework explains how a verified \$50M position can be transformed into deployable financing through proof-of-funds anchoring, structured credit vehicles, and collateral-backed leverage lines, with strict compliance and custody controls.

## Who This Document Is For

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Teams preparing an institutional-ready financing package and deciding the highest-efficiency path from treasury capital to credit expansion.

## Required Information

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- Capital composition (cash, stablecoins, assets, receivables, tokenized assets, or statement-only)
- Encumbrance status and lock status
- Custody and control model
- Jurisdiction and legal wrapper requirements
- Target leverage objective and risk tolerance

## Step-by-Step Process

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### Step 1: Classify the \$50M Capital Form

Determine whether the position is liquid cash/stablecoin, hard assets, receivables, tokenized collateral, or statement-only. This selects the funding route.

### Step 2: Route A — Proof-of-Funds Anchor

Use verified, locked, non-encumbered capital as first-loss buffer and risk offset to unlock credit multipliers from conservative to structured desks.

### Step 3: Route B — Structured Credit Facility

Place capital into an SPV or trust wrapper, define capital stack, and issue notes/participations under legal and custody controls.

### Step 4: Route C — Collateral of Record Line

Place collateral with custodian/trustee, issue collateral confirmation letter, and secure a leverage line without lender taking direct possession.

### Step 5: Attach Verification Stack

Bundle CIS, PoF verification, account lock status, wallet/custody confirmations, and compliance outcomes into one institutional packet.

### Step 6: Finalize Funding Path by Capital Type

Liquid capital favors Route A+C for speed; asset-heavy or receivable-heavy positions favor Route B for institutional acceptance and higher stack flexibility.
